

Greater Week 3 Study Questions

Read Nahum 2 and 3

What are the reasons the text gives for God's judgment on Nineveh?

How will the nations react to Nineveh's destruction?

Read Romans 12:17-21

How does it help us to know that God is in control and will ultimately judge those who need to be judged?

According to the verses, how should we react to our enemies knowing the truth of verse 19?

What current news or international events frighten people today?

In light of what we know from Romans and Nahum, what are ways a Christian should respond to these events?

Read and Memorize 2 Corinthians 5:21. Spend a few moments thanking God for Christ's sacrifice on our behalf.

Head Start: Read Habakkuk 1 in preparation for this Sunday. Record observations in the three areas below. TIP: The application part will be much easier if you've spent time engaging with the first two areas.

OBSERVATION - Make notes on what's described in the text. Be a detective in the text. Look for the who, what, when, where, why, and how. What's repeated? Are there comparisons/contrasts?

ASK QUESTIONS - If you don't understand something, write it down and seek out an answer.

APPLICATIONS - Think about the question: What difference does this make in my life?
